You will gain the technical skills and gain practical hand's-on conservation knowledge to carry out operational conservation work and provide sustainable stewardship of the environment while working respectfully with the Treaty of Waitangi, local iwi or hāpu, tikanga and kawa.

Programme Specific Information:

Duration 1 year, full-time programme, or equivalent part-time.

Delivery will be on campus, online and block courses.

Entry requirements

- Achieved NCEA Level 2 (credits in Numeracy, Science or English desirable) OR
- NZ Certificate in Pest Operations (Level 3)
 OR
- Equivalent Academic Achievement OR
- On a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Director of School
