

# New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Academic) Level 4

This 15 week full-time programme is intended for learners of English as an additional language, who wish to pursue further English language study in an academic context.

- understand main ideas and supporting details of moderately complex oral academic texts.
- participate effectively in sustained spoken academic discourse.
- understand main ideas and supporting details of moderately complex written academic texts.
- write detailed, developed, moderately complex academic texts.

Holders of the New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Academic) (Level 4) will have the English language skills to work in positions that require:

- Interpersonal communication
- Understanding of context-specific professional and/or technical texts

- Interaction in a team.

### CEL4.001

English Listening

This course aims to provide the student with skills and techniques to understand main ideas and key supporting details of moderately complex oral academic texts.

### CEL4.002

English Speaking

This course aims to provide the student with skills and techniques to participate effectively in sustained spoken academic discourse.

### CEL4.003

English Reading

This course aims to provide the student with skills and techniques to understand main ideas and supporting details of moderately complex written academic texts.

### CEL4.004

English Writing

This course aims to provide the student with skills and techniques to write detailed, developed, moderately complex academic texts.
