- implement person-centred approaches to support a person with complex needs.
- take a leadership role in a health or wellbeing setting.

Programme Specific Information

Work placement components

Students must be employed in the health care sector and are required to complete 200 hours of work placement in their organisation throughout the duration of the programme. Competency for many of the programmes' assessments will typically be demonstrated in a workplace environment.

To pass each course, the work placement component must have been met.

Further study options

This qualification builds on the NZ Certificate in Health and Wellbeing Health Assistance or Support Work strands, and may lead to further study in related health and wellbeing settings, or in leadership and management.

Career Options:

Graduates of this programme may be employed as a health care assistant, senior caregiver, senior health care assistant or senior support worker in hospices or specialised dementia units, aged residential care or home and community support settings.

The programme has four courses and will run over 38 weeks part time.
