This programme is designed for people who wish to embark on tertiary study but do not yet have the skills required to study at tertiary level. This programme aims to provide foundation level students with the means to clarify their career and educational aspirations. It is an introductory level certificate that encourages students to develop basic skills and self-confidence, and assists them to select an appropriate programme of further study. This programme is developed to be multi-entry and multi-exit allowing flexibility for students to engage in individual education plans that will either lead to nationally recognised qualifications, entry to the workforce or to gain entry to higher level qualifications.
